Bullies, bystanders, parents, school officials and the community at large can tell their stories, seek help and support, as well as find information on bullying and a wide range of other youth issues. The website receives hundreds of visits a day from all over the world and with the weekly e-newsletter, you are sure to stay on top of all bullying stories in Canada.

Not only have they been in countless news stories across the country in four different languages, Katie and Rob are also being put in the E-Learning Ontario curriculum, in an English as a Second Language textbook in the Middle East and their website was also part of an anti-bullying unit at a college in France!

The team work endlessly to help people deal with bullying on all levels and have also talked many teens out of suicide, as well as helping bullies end their violent ways.

The website contains many different resources for people of all ages and professions to seek information on bullying and any other issue children and youth will have to face on the road to adulthood. Both Katie and Rob go into schools and give presentations to groups both large and small about the severity of bullying in many people's lives.

BullyingCanada.Ca is run solely off of donations and is in the process of become a charity process. They believe that no issue is too big or too small and they will be found working to end bullying. Their goal is to work so that nobody ever has to go through what they did growing up at school.
