Child Health - Preconception, prenatal and postnatal education, parent education and workshops, breast feeding support, child development, school readiness and vision screening. Healthy Babies Healthy Children -a voluntary program that emphasizes prevention and early intervention to help children from before birth to age six to get a healthy start in life, breast feeding support. Dental Services -for children 17 and under with no dental insurance & not covered by Ontario Works. <u>Children in Need of Treatment (CINOT)</u> - only immediate/urgent dental care, must first be screened by oral health staff. <u>Healthy Smiles Ontario (HSO)</u> -must have family net incomes less than \$20,000 yearly. Dental service includes preventative care.
